# From Ministry Coordinator Nikki Ehrichs....

As I type this Easter is just around the corner and I find myself thinking about a conversation I had with my grandpa in the summer of 2003. We were on our way home from a funeral in Montana. Grandpa wasn't comfortable making the drive himself, so I took him. As we were heading east into North Dakota he shared about how it was at a Good Friday service he surrendered his life to Christ back in 1944. Grandpa said the preacher read Jesus' last words "It is finished." and it hit him, only Jesus could take his sins away. Nothing else mattered, not being good, or trying hard, nothing. Grandpa said, "Jesus died and rose again, Nikki, there is nothing more important in life than knowing Him."

I think about that morning drive with Grandpa every year around Easter, I think of it other times as well, but always at Easter. For Christians, Jesus' death on the cross and resurrection three days later is the foundation of our faith. "And if Christ has not been raised, our preaching is useless and so is your faith." (1 Corinthians 15:14) We cannot have forgiveness, freedom from condemnation, and hope of eternal life if Jesus hadn't died and rose again. My husband Jeff put it so simply "Without Easter, we are doomed!" But the tomb *was* empty. ("He is not here; he has risen!" Luke 24:6) For those who put their trust in Him, there is forgiveness, there is hope, there is life. I can think of nothing in all of history that is more significant or is a greater cause for jubilation.

But if you have been to any store lately it's very apparent that Easter has become quite commercialized. There are baskets, bunnies, plastic eggs, peeps and jelly beans everywhere. You can even get a pastel colored stuffed animal the size of a compact car! Now, I'm as fond of fuzzy rabbits as anyone, I don't know what that has to do with Easter. None of these things are bad in and of themselves, they are not the reason we celebrate Easter. We celebrate because Jesus died for our sins, rose again and is alive! As the words of the chorus from the hymn "He Lives" proclaim, "He lives, He lives, Christ Jesus lives today! He walks with me and talks with me along life's narrow way. He lives, He lives, salvation to impart! You ask me how I know He lives? He lives within my heart."

Let's celebrate the joy, the hope, and the life we can have not only on Resurrection Sunday, but every day! Because He Lives!






